<p>2. What is the difference in jurisdiction between Lembaga Tabung Haji (TH) and JAWHAR?</p>	<p>1. TH is a statutory body established by the Government of Malaysia in 1963 and governed by the Tabung Haji Act 1995 (Act 535). TH provides facilities for Muslims in the country to save money to perform Hajj. TH has over 50 years of experience in savings, pilgrimage, and investment services. As one of the country's leading hajj institution, TH strives to strengthen the economy of Malaysian Muslims by utilizing existing</p>

JAWHAR is preparing a guideline and monitoring mechanism for the management of Hajj Furada and Badal Hajj together with Lembaga Tabung Haji (TH) and Hajj Pilgrimage Coordinator (PJH) to facilitate the management of Hajj through Furada Hajj Visa (VHF) more systematically because of this VHF cannot be cancelled as this privilege was awarded by the Embassy of Saudi Arabia.</li> <li>ii. JAWHAR will find an approach that can educate the community such as implementing guidance and briefing programs to deal with fraudulent Hajj Furada and Badal Hajj packages.</li> </ul>
